The RINJ Foundation PROTOCOL ON SHARP INJURY

To prevent sharp injury, and ensure safety of the patient and personnel, the following procedure must be followed closely:

- 1. Contaminated Sharps are placed on a Kidney/Emesis Basin (i.e. Sutures Needles, Scalpel Blades).
- 2. If the procedure necessitates reuse of a Hypodermic Needle for multiple times on the patient, use the <u>SCOOP METHOD</u> (lay the needle cap toward the back of the Mayo Stand and slide the needle within the cap).
- 3. A sterile sharps container is provided and should be used on every case to store used Sharps (yellow bins).
- 4. When organizing the Sharp in the work area, Sharps should be pointed away from the handler and receiving personnel.
- 5. Visual inspection of the field and drapes for any sharps before disposal must be done.
- 6. Utilize mechanical Safety Device to remove or attach blades/needles or other sharps . (i.e. needle driver to remove your scalper blade)
- 7. Non-sterile Sharp Container is in place for all staff to dispose sharps to decrease the risk of injury to patients and personnel.
